# Graduation Requirements

## Civic Literacy Competency Requirement

In accordance with the State Board of Education Rule 6A-10.02413, prior to the award of the Associate in Arts or the baccalaureate degree, students initially entering a Florida College System institution in the 2021-2022 academic year, and thereafter, must demonstrate competency in civic literacy by achieving a passing score on the Florida Civic Literacy Exam and by successfully passing a civic literacy course. This requirement must be satisfied through the following two criteria prior to graduation:

1. Successfully passing either POS X041 American Government or AMH X020 Introductory Survey Since 1877. Each of these courses must include the following competencies:

- Understanding of the basic principles and practices of American democracy and how they are applied in our republican form of government;
- An understanding of the United States Constitution and its application;
- Knowledge of the founding documents and how they have shaped the nature and functions of our institutions of self-government; and
- An understanding of landmark Supreme Court cases, landmark legislation, and landmark executive actions and their impact on law and society.

2. Achieving the standard score on one of the following assessments\*:

<u>Assessment</u>	<u>Score</u>
• AP Government and Politics: United States	3
• AP United States History	4
• CLEP: American Government	50
• Florida Civic Literacy Exam	60%

\*Credits earned in articulated acceleration mechanisms in s. 1007.27 will count toward the civic literacy requirement.
