The A.S. degree in Emergency Medical Services Technology consists of completion of EMT Certification, Paramedic Certification, and General Education Requirements. The EMT and Paramedic programs are limited access. Please review the application requirements.

Following the completion of the A.S. degree, you will be eligible for admission into the Florida SouthWestern State College Bachelor of Applied Science degree in Public Safety Administration.
